There will be a chili dinner before the parade at The Buhl Senior Center, 1010 Main Street. Chili will be served starting at 5:00 pm - \$5.00 per person.

The ATV club will be meeting at 6:30 PM to line up. The parade will begin at 7:00 PM.

At the conclusion of the parade, the club will be meeting at the First Christian Church (corner of Poplar and Broadway) for coffee, hot cocoa, and cookies.

When you enter Buhl the Valley Coop will be on your right, just past that is a Stop light, get in the left lane and make a half left which will put you on Truck Lane or the Castleford Road, Go about a half mile and on the left is where the parade will be lining up

IF YOU CONTINUE ON HWY 30 (Broadway) TO MAIN STREET, THE SENIOR CITIZEN'S CENTER IS ½ BLOCK ON THE LEFT. IF YOU CONTINUE ON HWY 30 FOR 3 MORE BLOCKS THE FIRST CHRISTIAN CHURCH IS ON THE LEFT.

If you wish, you may unload your ATV at the church and ride to the parade starting point so your vehicle will be at the church when you finish the parade. (Parade route finishes one block from church) If you park at the church, please avoid riding on Hwy 30 use the back streets. If you would like to donate some cookies, we would greatly appreciate it!

**On Saturday, Nov., 9th the MVATVR** club held a ride north of Kimama. We met at exit 208 Burley. Traveling north past the town of Paul we proceeded to the railroad community of Kimama. Kimama was a local shipping point years ago for sheep and cattle by train. Only huge grain storage bins remain for rail shipments. Crossing the tracks 3 miles to unload site at Peavey corrals; 17 machines were unloaded. Going north about 6 miles we turned east on Cream Can road. Continuing east we arrive at Peavey well for first break. (see picks on web).

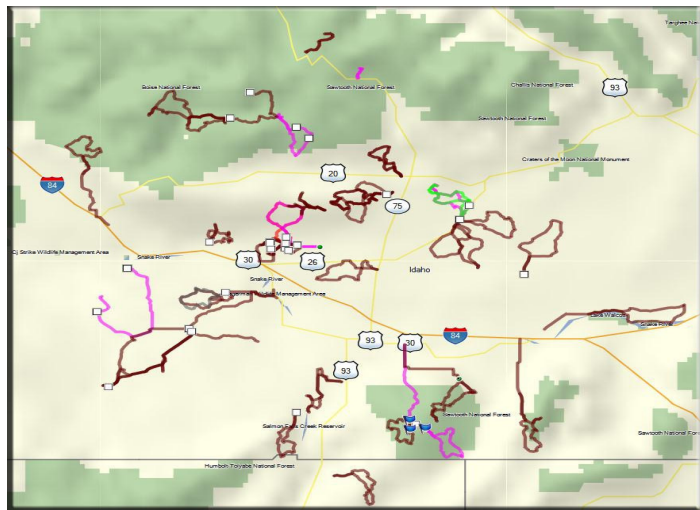
Leaving this, we traveled east to a junction which is the start of the Minidoka crossing. Turning north we headed into the lavas for lunch before crossing the lavas. Minidoka crossing was one of the first roads which crossed a lava flow. This is a winding trail for about 3 miles through the lavas. (web picks.) Many cracks in the lava were filled in with small lava to allow crossing of the cracks. Leaving the lavas we proceeded west to the air strip next to Wild horse mountain. A few hearty souls raced down the runway. Jeanette won her race. Oh she was by herself!!

We completed the ride back to loading zone, about 53 miles. Jerry wasn't too far off on miles estimated (45+) Beautiful day. little wind, no rain. Thanks to Jeanette and Frank for the pictures taken for the web site.. Ride was led by Jerry and Lanny, We thank you for following us.
