As of December 31, 2018 they have distributed approximately 350 beds (frame, mattress, sheets, pillow, and a handmade quilt), currently averaging \$250.00 per bed. This ministry is 100% funded by private donations.

We are asking everyone to bring a non-perishable food item(s) to contribute towards the Mustard Seed's food pantry as well. We understand that their shelves are pretty bare after helping many local community members get through the holiday season. Let's see if we can fill the foyer with food, which will in turn help refill their shelves! Greeters will collect your canned food donation(s) as you enter.
